

**INSTRUCTIONS
FOR
APPLICATION FOR INITIAL MEMBERSHIP
OR REINSTATEMENT INTO THE
SYSTEM SAFETY SOCIETY**

To be acceptable for processing, your application must include the following:

- Completed and signed official society application form.
- Evidence of claimed qualifications as specified.
- Check or money order covering fees required.

Applications will be reviewed by the Membership Committee for category assignment based on criteria in the By-laws. Requests for re-evaluation based on evidence of new or additional qualifications may be submitted at any time. Membership categories include:

- **STUDENT** — Limited to those currently enrolled in a course of study related to System Safety found acceptable to the committee. The reduced fees associated with Student category will be valid only upon submittal of evidence of continued enrollment at time of annual dues billing.
- **AFFILIATE** — The entry level category assigned to applicants not yet having qualifications needed for Member Grade designation or are not directly involved in System Safety-related efforts, but hold an acceptable professional degree in an allied field (i.e., Engineering, Medicine, Science, Law, Education, Management) and interact with System Safety activities.
- **MEMBER** — The grade assigned upon receipt of suitable evidence indicating the applicant has completed the experience/educational criteria established by the By-laws. These are indicated on the reverse side of the application form.
- **SENIOR MEMBER** — The grade assigned by the Professional Development Committee to those providing evidence of a high degree of competence in System Safety management and techniques.
- **FELLOW** — A grade assigned only to Senior Members having provided exceptional service to the Society and/or the advancement of the System Safety concept.

Note: A special upgrade form must be obtained and submitted for Senior or Fellow category designation consideration. Only Member, Senior and Fellow categories are eligible to hold office on the executive Council.

The front side of the application form must be completed by all applicants, the reverse side is only for those requesting consideration for Member grade.

To be eligible for the Student fee discount, applicant must include a copy of transcript or similar evidence of enrollment, including a statement indicating the nature of the courses being taken, and anticipated involvement in system safety related activities.

The appropriate application fee (see below) must accompany your application submittal. This fee is to be paid by check, or money order, made payable to — SYSTEM SAFETY SOCIETY — in U.S. dollars (if other currency is submitted, any added costs for conversion to U.S. dollars will be billed applicant).

* The “Reinstatement Fee” is limited to the case of a former member applying to be replaced on the active list, within 3 years of being dropped for failure to pay annual dues. Otherwise, full fee required.
